# **World Languages Final Project**

**INSTRUCTIONS:** Your final project is to create a digital presentation/infographic about any language that we have not covered in class (and also not English). - 5. The following words in the language:
  - a. Hello (if there are both formal and informal ways to do this, make sure to include both and label them)

  - c. Numbers 1-10
- 6. Two cultural facts about a country that speaks this language
- 7. Any other information you think is important, relevant, or necessary

## **Poster Design**
